SUCCESS STORY - Working in Ballard on behalf of the Alliance, Paige found long-term housing for Mama Jan, who was living in a tent near the Ballard Library and had been homeless for 30 years. Mama Jan took care of many in the Ballard homeless community and found many barriers to finding permanent housing. Her primary issue was getting a Washington State ID and the challenges with finding a Ballard landlord willing to sign a lease. With Paige's help and efforts by colleagues at REACH, Jan was able to restore her ID, find an apartment and help her furnish it. Additionally, Paige connected her with a Ballard volunteer agency where Jan can continue her work helping the Ballard homeless community.

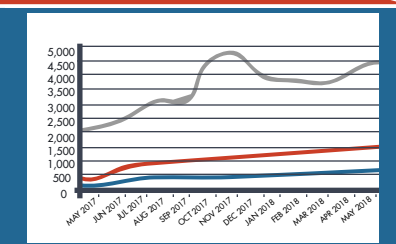


PLANNING BALLARD'S TRANSPORTATION FUTURE

Sound Transit's plan to extend light rail to Ballard is the most critical initiative facing our community that has the potential to dramatically change the landscape of Ballard and its connections to the rest of the City for the next 100 years. The Ballard Alliance was appointed to Sound Transit's Stakeholder Advisory Group that will spend the next 14 months providing input and guidance on the specific alignment and infrastructure for this light rail line. Representing Ballard, we are tirelessly advocating for a tunneled alignment that appropriately serve Ballard's dense Urban Village as well as preserve needed freight corridors and not impede the passage of commercial vessel traffic within the ship canal.
